Students should consider long underwear, Under Armor, etc. when the weather is predicted to be cold.** When they come off the field after the half-time show, they will change out of their uniforms and will need their uniform bags, shako (hat) boxes, and instrument cases to protect and store their uniforms and instruments in their vehicles. They will also need warm clothes if they return to watch the second half of the game.

- Black bib pants
- Black gauntlets, Black gloves, Black marching shoes, calf-length Black SOXES
